The TechShare Judicial Portal was developed with the needs of judges in mind while providing a user-friendly, effective case management experience. Our goal is to allow judges to easily access the information required to effectively manage their courtroom.

The TechShare Judicial Portal interfaces with any court case management software as well as with other TechShare products.

The portal is currently live in Potter County. Dallas and Tarrant Counties are piloting the portal, with connections to their existing mainframe systems. Dallas and Tarrant expect to put the portal in use by the end of the year. TechShare is program of the Texas Conference of Urban Counties, a non-profit association for local government.
