Company Representative Registration

Each year, Urban Counties holds the premier conference in Texas for urban county officials – the Urban Counties Education and Policy Conference. A limited number of underwriting opportunities are available to those entities that wish to spend high-quality time in a relaxed, casual atmosphere, with more than 100 county leaders ready to listen and learn about new ideas.

Each sponsor underwrites the conference for \$6,000, which includes one attendee registration and the opportunity to register additional representatives at the regular conference rate. Registrants may attend all conference events as full participants.

Sponsors receive logo recognition and the opportunity to place an educational article in the printed conference program. Urban Counties Membership Luncheons

Urban Counties conducts regular business Membership Luncheons. Average attendance is around 75 county officials and staff. Luncheons are held quarterly except for during regular sessions of the legislature, when they are held monthly.
